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#### ABSTRACT

Tables of altitudes of land and water surface at selected wells and stream cross sections and sketches of their locations from 10 districts in the Terai are aggregated in this leveling report. The districts are Saptari, Siraha, Dhanusha, Mahottari, Sarlahi, Chitwan, Banke, Bardiya, Kailali and Kanchanpur.

#### INTRODUCTION

#### Purpose and scope

A project, NEP/86/025, to investigate the shallow ground water resources of Terai districts began in 1987. The United Nations Department of Technical Co-operation for Development and the Ground Water Resources Development Board, HMG, Nepal are the responsible entities. This data report on altitude of land surface at wells, of water surface at stream cross sections and sketches of well and cross section locations is one of a series of reports reporting on the information gained from the project.

The purpose of this data report is to present in one document the information gained from 10 district leveling reports on altitudes and locations of project wells and altitudes and locations of water surface at selected stream cross sections. The 10 districts are Saptari, Siraha, Dhanusha, Mahottari, Sarlahi, Chitwan, Banke, Bardiya, Kailali, and Kanchanpur. Banke District was done in 1990 but the other 9 districts were begun in April 1991 and completed by December 15, 1991.

These 10 districts were all contracted to and done by DEVTEC NEPAL PRIVATE LTD. Department of Irrigation (DOI) was responsible for the Banke District contract and NEP/86/025 was responsible for the contracts with the other 9 districts.

#### Materials provided to Devtec

Devtec was provided a map of each district showing the location of the wells and cross sections to be surveyed. They were provided with a letter "To whom it may concern" indicating that Devtec was performing a survey for project NEP/86/025. They also received a letter for each of the DOI officers in charge of the respective districts as a person was provided by the offices to show Devtec the wells on the ground.

# Terms and conditions of contract with Devtec

- 1. To measure exact spot height altitude of wells with reference to standard Bench Mark and to stick to those wells designated on the maps given by NEP/86/025.
- 2. If no bench marks are available in a district, a reference point will be set and all surveying will be related to that point.
- 3. To measure absolute water level altitude of the streams and rivers at the designated places on the provided maps.
- 4. To provide a detailed sketch map and description of each measured well and stream altitude separately so that anybody can locate the well or stream exactly in the field as illustrated in the figure at the bottom of the page.
- 5. To mention exact well condition as it exists such as acceptable, damaged, cap open, cap closed and etc.
- 6. To complete the districts by a specified time. For example, the last group of districts had to be completed and the reports submitted to NEP/86/025 by December 15, 1991.
- 7. Survey accuracy and adequacy will be determined by the GWRDP office and officer in charge which looks after the respective districts.
- 8. To provide a list of surveyors and details about the numbers, qualifications, and experience of the crews in each district.
- 9. To provide the starting and ending dates of the survey in each district. Provide duration in the field and methods of transportation to, from and in the field.
- 10. To describe the methodology of surveying in detail including methods of transportation, line-kilometer coverage, errors, accuracy, any limitations and etc.
- 11. To provide a small index map of Nepal showing the district surveyed.
- 12. To submit five copies of the final report for each individual district to NEP/86/025.

## Location and extent of area

The distribution of the 10 districts is shown in Figure 1. The districts without sketches of the well locations are also shown as there are ground water reports for all districts.

## Methods of investigation

To quote the Devtec reports, "The levelling survey work was conducted by fly levelling with double reading method to avoid reading error. The readings were computed by Rise and Fall method. The back-sight and fore-sight had been taken from the same setting of the instrument. Maximum necessary precautions were taken to minimize the possible errors, such as instrumental, personal and errors due to natural sources." All altitudes and elevations in the report are in meters (m).

#### Acknowledgment

Thanks and appreciation are expressed to the field offices, GWRDB, which provided requested assistance to Devtec, and to the workers at Devtec.

#### Leveling data

There is a location map, a table and a series of sketches for each district. The tables contain a well number, a village name, a ward number, and the altitude of land surface in meters at the well or the altitude of the water surface in the stream cross section. Each districts' table has an accompanying set of sketches of the locations of individual wells. The districts are presented from east to west.

The well numbers serve to identify the wells as this projects wells, UN followed by a number; private wells, PW followed by a number; dug wells, DG followed by a number; deep wells, DW followed by a number. The cross sections are identified as cross section, CS followed by a number. These well and cross section numbers correspond to the numbers on the location maps of the districts and on the sketches of the well locations.

The altitudes in the tables for Kanchanpur, Kailali, and Bardiya districts are referred to arbitrary, temporary bench marks and are not actual nor necessarily realistic altitudes. When real and accurate bench marks become available these altitudes must be corrected.



## Saptari District

Land surface altitudes at 37 wells and the water surface altitudes at 6 stream cross sections were determined in Saptari District. There were 32 UN wells, 1 private shallow well, 1 private deep well, 3 other deep wells and 6 stream cross sections surveyed. Locations are shown on the district map, Figure 2; altitudes are listed in Table 1; sketches of the wells and cross sections are shown in Figures 3 - 13.

## Siraha District

Land surface altitudes at 36 wells and the water surface altitudes at 7 stream cross sections were determined in Siraha District. There were 23 UN wells, 13 deep wells and 7 stream cross sections surveyed. Locations are shown on the district map, Figure 14; altitudes are listed in Table 2; sketches of the wells and cross sections are shown in Figures 15 - 25.
